2022 K/A Productions Year-End High Point Awards

High Point Trainer

This award is determined through the accumulation of a trainer's individual riders participating in any class with the exception of lead line, medals, hunter derbies and jumper classics.

High Point Junior Rider 2'6"

This High point award is for riders with a show age of 17 & under participating in classes 2'6 and higher in hunters and equitation. This excludes medals and derbies.

Hight Point Amateur Rider 2'6"

This High point award is for riders with a show age of 18 & Over participating in classes 2'6 and higher in hunters and equitation. This excludes medals and derbies.

High Point Junior Jumper Rider

This High point award is for riders with a show age of 17 & under participating in jumper classes of any height.

This excludes jumper classics.

High Point Amateur Rider

This High point award is for riders with a show age of 18 & Over participating in jumpers classes of any height.

This excludes jumper classics.

High Point TB Hunter

This High point award is for all TB's in the hunter classes of any height. This excludes, lead line, derbies, equitation and medals.

All TB horses must be declared in the horse show office by the end of the show. Points will not be retroactive.

High Point TB Jumpers

This High point award is for all TB's in the jumper classes of any height. This excludes, jumper classics. All TB horses must be declared in the horse show office by the end of the show. Points will not be retroactive.

High Point Newbie Rider

This High point award consists of classes from the walk trot to 2'3 hunters and equitation.

This excludes jumper classes, medals and derbies.

The following apply to all of the High Point Awards:

- *Riders must participate in a minimum of four (4) K/A productions and/or Paddock shows to be eligible for high point awards.
- *There must be a minimum of three (3) riders in a class for points to count.
- *The points are awarded as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1,.5
- *Champions will receive a ribbon and cooler
- *Reserve Champions will receive a ribbon

Entry Agreement

By entering this competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the Southern California Horse Show Association, the Los Angeles Hunter Jumper Association, the Pacific Coast Horse Show Association, each an Affiliate of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation"), the Santa Barbara County Riding Club and the Paddock Riding Club. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action constituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State, see GR908.4. Action against the SCHSA, LAHJA, PCHA or SBCRC must be filed in California.

Release, Assumption of Risk, Waiver, and Indemnification. This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition to the following:

I AGREE that the "Competition" as used herein includes the Facility, Licensee and Competition Management, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and Federation affiliates.

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the competition with my horse, as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm").

I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Facility and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Federation of the Competition.

I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of the Federation or the Competition.

I AGREE to indemnify (that is, pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Facility, Management, and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse while at the Competition. I have read the Federation Rules about protective equipment including GR801 and, if applicable, EV114, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Federation strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this Release on the child's behalf. I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in this competition.

I AGREE that if I am injured at this competition, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to all parties concerned.

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RULES, DEFINITIONS & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. This show will follow the rules of the USEF except where in conflict with LAHJA, SCHSA or PCHA, in which case local association rules will prevail. Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions rising out of incident, and to change any course, cancel, reschedule or combine classes with due notification to exhibitors. Classes with less than three entries may be combined or cancelled.
- 2. K/A Productions reserves the right to make all management decisions regarding the operation of the horse show and the conditions of competition allowed under the rules and sanctioning organizations.
- 3. Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold K/A Productions and the Paddock Riding Club harmless from injury to such minor. No child's entry blank shall be accepted unless a parent or guardian signs it. The signature of instructors, agents, or other unrelated persons will not be acceptable. The USEF Helmet Rule (GR801.4), effective 4/1/2012, will be strictly enforced.
- 4. Medal Classes are opened to only Junior and Adult Amateur members in good standing of the medal classes' association. Trainers must all be members. Additional rules available in show office and on websites: schcaonline.org, lahja.org and pchorseshows.org.
- 5. WALK/TROT CLASSES: To be eligible, riders in these class must not enter any other equitation classes at this show, except Cross Rails. Once a rider has competed over fences, he/she may not return to the Walk Trot Division.
- 6. CROSS RAIL HUNTERS: This division is open to riders that have not shown over a course of fences 2'3" or higher at any show.
- 7. STIRRUP CLASSES: SHORT (11 & Under), LONG (12-17), RUSTY (18-Over) Open to Junior/Amateur riders who enter or compete in classes where fence heights are posted to be set higher than 2'6".
- 8. JUNIOR /AMATEUR GREEN RIDER CLASSES: Fences 2'3" with no combinations. Riders may not enter or compete in classes where the fence heights are posted to be set higher than 2'6" during the current show year.
- 9. CHILDREN'S & ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS: Fences 2'6" / 2'9": 11 & UNDER HUNTERS, Fences 2'6"; 11 & UNDER EQUITATION, Fences 2'6"; 12 17 HUNTERS, Fences 2'9"; 12 17 EQUITATION, Fences 2'9"; 18 & OVER HUNTERS, Fences 2'9"; 18 & OVER EQUITATION, Fences 2'9". Classes may be combined. If combined, 11 & Under will stay at 2'6".12 and over will stay at 2'9".
- 10. CHILDREN'S PONY DIVISION: Fences 2' for Small/Med. and 2'6" for Large Ponies in this division do not have to be recorded. Because points are calculated on the riders if more than one pony is ridden in a class, only placing from the highest placing pony will count towards points.
- 11. PRE-CHILD / ADULT DIVISION. Fences 2'6". Open to junior and amateur competitors with no other entry restrictions.
- 12. LOW HUNTER DIVISION: Fences2'6". This division has no entry restrictions.
- 13. LOW CHILDRENS / ADULT AMATEUR DIVISION. Fences 2'9"
- 14. PRE-CHILD / ADULT DIVISON: Fences 2'6". Open to junior and amateur competitors with no other entry restrictions.
- 15. LOW HUNTER DIVISON: Fences 3'. This division has no entry restrictions.
- 16. THOROUGHBRED HUNTER DIVISION: Fences 3'. Horses must be registered Thoroughbreds.

RULES, DEFINITIONS & CLASS SPECIFICATIONS CONTINUED:

- 17. ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS: Fences 3'. Open to Adult Amateurs 18 & Over. May combine with Children's Hunters 3'
- 18. CHILDREN'S HUUNTERS: Fences 3'. Open to Children 17 and UNDER. May combine with Adult Amateur Hunters 3'
- 19. ADULT AMATEUR EQUITATION: Fences 3'. Open to Adult Amateurs 18 & Over. May combine with Children's Equitation 3'
- 20. CHILDREN'S EQUITATION: Fences 3'. Open to Children 17 and UNDER. May combine with Adult Amateur Equitation 3'
- 21. PERFORMANCE HUNTER DIVISION: Fences 3.3". This division has no entry restrictions.
- 22. JUNIOR HUNTERS: Fences 3'3". Junior (17 & UNDER) Classes will follow USEF Rules for age breaks.
- 23. AMATEUR OWNER HUNTERS: Fences 3'3". (18 & OVER) Classes will follow USEF Rules for age breaks.
- 24. .65M SHORT/LONG/RUSTY JUMPERS: Fences .65m. Open to Junior and Amateur riders as defined in Short, Long, and Rusty Stirrup Divisions.
- 25. OPEN JUMPERS: See class for fence heights. No restrictions.
- 26. LOW CHILDREN'S/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPERS: See class for fence height. Open to Children and Adult Amateurs.
- 27. CHILDRENS'/ADULT AMATEUR JUMPERS: Fences 1.10m. Open to Children and Adult Amateurs
- 28. TB JUMPERS: See class for fence height. If there are enough Thoroughbred and standard entries, the class will be broken up into one TB class and one Open Jumper class. Thoroughbreds must be registered.
- 29. BLUE/RED WARM-UP CLASSES: Open all day and may be ridden prior to a division at that height. ONLY One round per horse at specific height.
- 30. Classes ridden in, but not entered, will be subject to a \$25 Rode Did Not Enter (RDNE) Fee. Classes must be scratched before the start of the class to receive a refund.
- 31. Entries with returned checks or declined credit cards will incur a \$35 fee. Scratched entries will incur a \$35 Scratch Fee.
- 32. Dogs must be on a leash at all times

2' Hunter Derby

Open to Junior & Amateur horse, pony and rider combination who are competing in the 2' - 2'3 divisions or classes. Riders must not have shown in any classes with heights of 2'6 or higher. Riders may show multiple horses in this class. The class consists of one (1) round and will include 2 tests, either a trot jump, a halt, and/or option fences of the course designer's choice. Judge has the option to ask a question at their discretion.

2'6 Hunter Derby

Sponsored by : Horse on The Loose

Open to Junior & Amateur horse, pony and rider combination who are competing the 2'6"-2'9". Riders must not have shown in any classes with heights of 3' or higher at the show. Riders may show multiple horses in this class. The class consists of one (1) round and will include 2 tests, either a trot jump, a halt, and/or option fences of the course designer's choice. Judge has the option to ask a question at their discretion.

3'0 Hunter Derby

Sponsored by: Ethos Equestrian

Open to all Open, Junior, & Amateur horse, pony and rider combinations in the 2'9" - 3'6" Divisions. Riders may show multiple horses in this class. The class consists of one (1) round and will include 2 tests, either a trot jump, a halt, and/or option fences of the course designer's choice.

1.00m Jumper Classic

Sponsored by: Game7 PEMP

Open to all horse, pony and rider combination with fence height set at 1.00M. 50% to first, 30% to second, 20% to third. 5 must compete for class to go. \$20 Add back. Ribbons 1st-6th place. A Special award given to the Champion

Show High Point Awards

Points: 10/1st, 6/2nd, 4/3rd, 2/4th, 1/5th, 0.5/6^{th:} Points are accumulated per class and are based on a minimum of 3 riders per class unless otherwise noted. Classes without 3 riders are not included in points accumulation. Trainers & Riders must enter a minimum of 4 shows for points to count (K/A Productions (aka Fun Under the Sun) or Paddock Hunter/Jumper Shows).

TRAINER HIGH POINT: Points are accumulated from all of the trainer's riders. There must be 3 riders in the class for points to count.

JUNIOR RIDER (HUNTER & EQUITATION) HIGH POINT: Open to riders 17 & Under. Points are accumulated from all hunter and equitation classes with 3 or more riders.

AMATEUR RDIER (HUNTER & EQUITATION) HIGH POINT: Open to riders 18 & Over. Points are accumulated from all hunter and equitation classes with 3 or more riders.

JUMPER HIGH POINT: Open to all Junior and Amateur Riders. Points are accumulated on all jumper classes with 2 or more riders.

THOROUGHBRED HUNTER HIGH POINT: Horse must be registered as a Thoroughbred (notify show office). Points are accumulated from all Hunter classes with 3 or more riders.

THOROUGHBRED JUMPER HIGH POINT: Horse must be registered as a Thoroughbred (notify show office). Points are accumulated from all Jumper classes with 3 or more riders.
